## **OVERVIEW**

The Prosperity Index is a unique and robust assessment of global wealth and wellbeing, benchmarking 142 countries in eight distinct categories.


The Index is comprised of 89 individual indicators and has six consecutive years of comparable data.

Hungary ranks 39th globally in the 2014 Prosperity Index, having risen two places since last year.

Hungary's best performance is in the Education sub-index, where it ranks 32nd in 2014.

Hungary's lowest rank is in the Social Capital sub-index, where it ranks 75th in 2014.
